of Virginians reported driving after drinking too much in the **past 30 days**.
Based on Virginia's current population this means that over



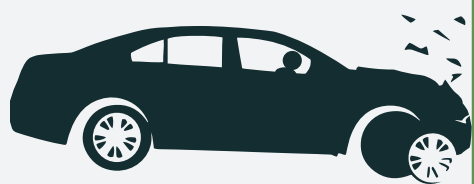
100,000

people admit to driving drunk every month.

From **2003-2012**, **2,613** people were killed in crashes involving a drunk driver in Virginia, which means that, on average, over **260** Virginians die every year in drunk driving crashes.

8 Teenagers were **killed**

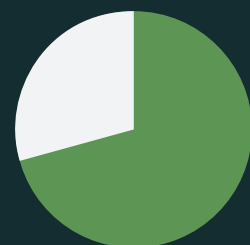

*Legal limit = .08 BAC

Of those convicted of a DUI, **70%** were **male**



Males were about **four times more likely** than females **to die** in an alcohol-related crash.
